Improving skills in the community

SA Training & Consulting (SATC), is a locally owned and managed Registered Training Organisation (RTO) based in the Murraylands.

SATC has been delivering Certificate II and III Conservation and Land Management and Agricultural training in the Murraylands since achieving RTO status in 2009.

SATC has recently seen 12 Indigenous students graduate from a Certificate III in CLM qualification from NRC (Ngarrindjeri Ruwe Contracting).

SATC and NRC continue to work together to provide a customised employment based training in response to the changing environmental management requirement in the region.

SATC also has a number of trainees near completion of a Certificate III in CLM at Orana Melaluca Nursery, Meningie.

All training provided by SATC has been nursery based, utilising Melalucas venue and resources, therefore ensuring that all training is suited to the workplace.

Examples of workshops delivered by SATC include ChemCert Certificate, Senior First Aid, native seed identification and collection, plant nutrition and establishment, business documents, OHS in the workplace, communications in the workplace and more.

SATC provides all training locally, using local resources and where possible, at the students place of employment.

SATC is a small RTO, therefore enjoys the one-on-one relationship that is developed with students and employers, making for a more inclusive and comfortable learning environment.
